Let your soul be soothed and softened, as the dew revives the rose.

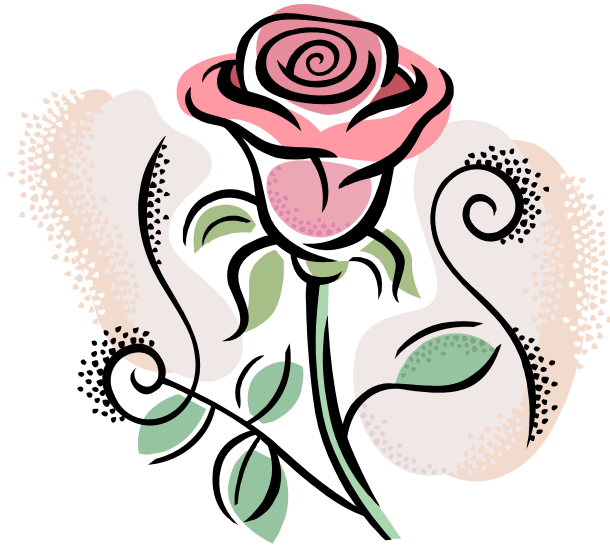
A moment in the morning take your Bible in your hand,
